4. Then select “Open Choice® PPO”


If you are an Aetna member, you may find your plan name on your member ID Card or in your Enrollment Documents



A doctor who provides both the first contact for a person with an undiagnosed health concern as well as continuing care of varied medical conditions.


[Adolescent Medicine Physician »](#)
